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One of the biggest reasons that people don't travel and live abroad is money. They feel like even if they save money while at home, they are eventually going to run out and have to come home.

Trying to find work abroad can be tough for a lot of people. Whether it's because they're living in a country that speaks a different language or they don't have a visa that allows them to work, it seems to be the main reason that stops a lot of people from living abroad.

Today that all changes because I'm going to tell you that it's possible to make money no matter where you are in the world.

When I first had the dream of being able to travel the world and live abroad, it was just that, a dream. I never believed that it was possible for me to work while living and travelling in a foreign country.

I'm happy to say I was wrong. It is in fact possible to make money from your computer. Myself and thousands of others have used this method to help fund a life of travel and adventure.

Don't worry we aren't going to be creating spam or illegally stealing people's bank details.

You're going to learn how to make money by writing SEO articles.

What is SEO Article Writing?

For those of you who are unfamiliar with this phrase, SEO stands for 'search engine optimization.' This basically means trying to rank your website on the first page of Google.

SEO article writing in particular is one small part of SEO and involves writing articles, normally 350-500 words in length, with certain keywords, and inputting those keywords in the article 2 or 3 times. Google then recognizes these keywords, and when people search for them, your website will rank highly.

If you still don't understand, don't be discouraged. I will give you some examples below.

How To Get Started

1. Write Samples

The first thing that you need to do if you want to start making money through SEO writing is writing 2 samples. It's important to write sample articles because everyone that you contact to ask for work is going to want to see some examples of your writing. This is just to ensure that you have a reasonable level of english and don't make grammatical errors and spelling mistakes.

You don't need to spend too long writing these sample articles because you can always write new ones later, once your writing starts to improve. I advise spending up to an hour writing each template, no longer.

Remember you don't have to write perfect articles! You should write two articles on two different topics that you enjoy writing about. This not only makes them easier to write for you, but shows to your clients what you are interested in writing about.

Below are the SEO articles that I used as my samples when I first started out:

Example 1:

(The keyword phrase is “buying a tennis racket”)

*“Things to Consider before **Buying a Tennis Racket**”*

*Whether you are a beginner or professional tennis player, **buying a tennis racket** is never an easy task. There are so many different things to consider before buying a racket. However there are a few key things to take into account.*

1. Racket Length and Weight A traditional tennis racket is between 68cm and 71cm long, yet you can buy rackets up to 74cm long. The longer the racket, the more power you can give to a shot. Most tennis rackets are made from graphite, which is light and suitable for any beginner. Titanium and aluminium rackets are also rather light, but give a better feel when hitting the ball. Tennis rackets are normally either weighted more at the head or the handle. Players who play at the net normally prefer a handle-heavy racket whereas players who prefer to play at the baseline normally prefer a head-heavy racket. Handle-heavy rackets generally offer more control, however it is harder to generate more spin and power. If you are a beginner you should opt for a head-heavy racket.

2. String Type and Tension Most rackets that you buy will be pre-strung with strings at a tension in the middle of the range. This is only recommended for beginners because the strings are not normally of very high quality. The lower the tension the harder you will hit the ball but the less control you will have. If you are looking for a string that is softer on the arm then you should consider a synthetic string like Synthetic Gut or Wilson Sensation. Unfortunately these strings break very easily and are rather expensive. A firmer, polyester string such as Volkl Cyclone will last longer and is more suitable for players who have a fast swing and can generate pace of their own.

3. Price A quality tennis racket is not cheap and advanced players can spend more than \$500 on a racket. Beginners should never spend more than \$50-\$150 dollars on their first racket. These rackets are not fully comprised of graphite and are normally suited for players who play every couple of weeks. If you play at least once a week then you should consider buying a racket made of titanium or aluminium, but you will have to spend a little more money.

Buying a tennis racket shouldn't be overwhelming or confusing, it should be fun. Remember to consider these three points before buying a racket and talk to an in-store professional if you are not sure which racket will be the best for you.

Example 2:

(The keyword phrase is "make yourself accountable")

*"How To **Make Yourself Accountable**"*

*A problem that many of us share is that although we have amazing plans for the future and we know what we want to do with our lives, we rarely follow through. This article is going to discuss how to **make yourself accountable** to follow through with your goals and life ambitions.*

Here are the key things that you need to do in order to follow your dreams and achieve your goals:

1. Set Dates

One of the hardest things to do is to give yourself a time limit of how long you have before you are going to achieve something or do something that scares the hell out of you. The worst thing that can happen if you fail is that you are back to square one where you would be if you didn't take the leap.

2. Tell Everyone

This is the easiest step to achieving your goals but one that people struggle with the most. The reason why people struggle with telling everyone is because they are afraid what people will think of them and they are afraid that if they don't achieve their goals, then they are going to look like a fool. Almost everyone gets embarrassed when they say they are going to do something but fail to. That is why this is such a great thing to do because by telling everyone you know, then you are held accountable. Your friends and family will often want to help you achieve your dreams so if you say to them "This is what I am going to do, and when I am going to do it by, please make sure that I follow through with this and constantly remind me" then you suddenly have a lot of support and your journey is a lot easier.

3. Write It Down

After setting a date, it is important to write it down. Too often people make plans and say that they are going to achieve a certain goal on a certain date and simply forget. They have nothing reminding them of the date that they said they were going to achieve their goal by. Whether you write it on a piece of paper and stick it next to your bed so it is the first thing you see when you get up and the last thing you see before you go to bed, or you have it on a card that you stick in your wallet and see every time you buy something, it doesn't really matter, but you need to be constantly reminded of the goals and dates that

you have set for yourself otherwise you will simply forget. By creating these constant reminders, you keep your goal on your radar and don't easily forget about it.

4. Take Action Everyday

This is one of the most important steps because if you aren't working towards your goal everyday then it is going to seem like a task that is unreachable. The best thing to do is to write down mini goals for each day that relate directly to achieving my overall goal and I think this is the best way to feel positive about making a change in your life and feel like the overall goal is not too difficult. For example if your goal was to live in a foreign country for 3 months then some of your daily goals could be to spend 30 minutes per day learning the language or planning the places that you want to visit while you are there. This is a great thing to do because you are helping achieve your goal bit by bit.

*Sticking to your goals doesn't have to be overwhelming and boring, you just need to **make yourself accountable**. Follow these four steps to make sure that you are able to live the life you want to lead.*

As you can see from the examples above, they aren't necessarily well written articles. They were both written in under an hour each.

It's important to note that you don't need to know much about the topic in order to write a 500 word article. You're mainly writing the article for the benefit of the search engine, and it doesn't necessarily have to be a very informative piece.

With that in mind, it still has to be readable, because search engines such as Google will penalize your sites ranking if they think you're just writing poorly written articles to rank highly in their search engines.

2. Set Your Price

When first starting out, there is a tendency for people to doubt the quality of their writing and subsequently undervalue their abilities.

There are people on freelance websites such as UpWork charging \$3-\$4 per article (they are often from non-English speaking countries).

DON'T DO THIS!

You need to charge the rate that you want to be making in the long term. SEO companies don't often like to increase the rate they're paying clients, and are likely to drop you as a writer if you ask for a pay increase.

I recommend charging at least \$15-\$20 per article. Remember these articles are taking you anywhere between 30-60 minutes to write when first starting out, so make sure you are being paid accordingly.

3. Find Work

This is often the stage where most people have the most resistance and stop. There are a couple of different ways to find work however.

You can firstly find work on a Freelance website such as Upwork and compete for jobs. This is often difficult because you are competing with people from other countries that are willing to write articles at a very low rate.

My **preferred method** is to simply do a Google search such as 'SEO company' or 'SEO company Melbourne.' From this search, I am going to get thousands of different results and all I have to do is write down the contact details for each company, I recommend keeping a list in an excel spreadsheet, and start contacting them. It only took me 2 hours to get a list of over 100 companies.

4. Contact Companies

After you have a list of 50-100 companies, start contacting them. The best way to contact them is to send them an email offering your services. It's best that you include the company name in each email so that it seems more personal and that you haven't been sending them a generic email that you have sent countless other companies. The email template should be short, clear and concise.

Email Template Example:

Dear [Company Name] Team,

I'm contacting you to offer my services as a freelance SEO content writer.

I understand how difficult it is to find writers that can put together a strong article for your client with a reasonable keyword density without making it sound terrible. As a native English speaker, I pride myself in offering you top quality articles in a fast and reliable manner. When you contract for writers, you need content that your clients will be happy with – and you need it fast! I am comfortable writing about any topic in a timeframe that suits you.

If you are in need of SEO content articles that will keep the audience reading but make the search engines happy, contact me today.

Rates and samples are available upon request.

I appreciate your time, and I look forward to hearing from you!

As you can see it's a simple email that showcases your ability to speak English and provide quality articles. Companies will normally start you off with a single article to make sure they're happy with your writing. If they like your work, they are likely to send you articles in batches of 5-10.

Note: You can expect a response rate of about 5-20% doing this. I received a 10% response rate, which was around 10 companies. Remember it only took me around 2 hours to find a list of 100 companies. It just shows you how easy it is to start finding work.

5. Start Writing

After finding clients and receiving jobs, all you have to do is start writing. Clients will send you keywords that they want to rank for, and often even send you resources they want you to use for the information, and then all you have to do is start writing.

Conclusion

If you follow the process above you'll be able to start funding your life of travel and living abroad just like I have.

It may not sound like the most interesting way to make money, and it isn't. However, it allows you to live anywhere in the world and truly live the life you want to live.

I can't tell you how great it felt receiving my first \$15 in my Paypal account only 2 days after I started this process.

If I can do it, so can you! Time to get started!
